The above named ships which have the notation of "Surveys Overdue-Class Suspended" in the Register Book, are understood to have been accepted by the B.V. Register as they lay, without drydocking or similar inspections, whatsoever at this port.

The "JURANDY" is stated to have put into the port of Bahia (Salvador), as a port of refuge, where she was subjected to claims by the shippers etc.

During cargo operations, at this port, a fire occurred on board in the early morning of the 9th instant, when "Gross Damage" was declared to the Authorities there.
