I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo respecting the steamer "FRESHENER", and to acquaint you that Glasgow Report No.69621 has now been placed before the Committee and a Docking Date of 5,45 assigned subject to set over stem and indented keel and shell plating port and starboard sides forward being permanently repaired and to the port hawsepipe being renewed at the first opportunity.

It is concluded the Surveyor is in error in referring in his report to the "damaged 'stern' plating" and it is assumed this is a typographical error and should read "stem" plating. Should this not be so perhaps you will be good enough to let me know.


