S. With reference to Liverpool First Entry Report No. 119768 on the steamer "FRESHPOOL", I think it well to inform you that the Committee have today assigned a class of "100A1 For Admiralty Tender Service" together with notations of "Lloyd's A & CP", "LMC 7,43 FD & OG".

It is concluded that, as in the cases of the sister ships and in accordance with the plans, angle frames have been fitted in the engine and boiler spaces and not bulb angle frames as reported, but it will be appreciated if you will kindly let me have confirmation on this point.
