Dear Sir,

With reference to the Special Survey which became due at the end of June last on the Steamer "ISIS" ex "FOUADIEH", approval was given for postponement of this inspection until the present month. I shall be glad if you will ascertain from Owners and let me know as soon as possible what arrangements have now been made for the Special Survey question to be carried out.

The machinery requirements of the Special Survey have been commenced by the following:-

Outboard feed pump,
Main engine driven pumps,
Main circulating pump,
Port and Starboard feed pump,
General service pump.
Fan engine.

The vessel's class is subject to permanent repairs being effected to shell plates D.5, 6 & 7 etc. starboard side and to No.5 keel plate (Wasted) being renewed at the Special Survey and to the forward main boiler not being used until repaired.

There is an "Endorsement" of class relating to shell plates 6 & 7 in 2nd below sheer port side indented.
