Motorship "EDWARD DEMBOWSKI"

Reverting to your letter of the 12th June, the report of a survey of this ship at Hamburg in June/August has now been before the Committee, and it is noted that the Special Survey of hull and machinery was carried out in drydock, the screwshaft drawn for examination and the Donkey Boiler Survey held.

Repairs were carried out at this time to the water end casing of the forward bilge/fire service pump, but it was recommended that this part should be again examined by the end of February, 1958, and the Committee have continued the class subject to this inspection being carried out by that time.

A record of Drydocking 7,57, and notations of SS Ham. 8,57, Engine Survey 8,57, Screwshaft Examination 7,57, and Donkey Boiler Survey 8,57 have been assigned.

Classification Certificates in respect of the Special Survey of hull and machinery are enclosed.
