Referring to the Secretary's letters dated the 14th inst., we have been in connection with the Owner who stated that a letter would be forwarded as soon as possible dealing with the transferring of the vessel's class to Bureau Veritas, and this will be forwarded to London immediately after being received.

As for the delayed report I beg to point out that the vessel was surveyed at Esbjerg during the Ice period. It was stated that the vessel would proceed to Copenhagen and the Survey would then be completed.

In the meantime the Owner communicated with the Bureau-Veritas and when being pressed for the completion of the Survey it was stated that the vessel's class now was transferred to the named Society and my report then forwarded.
