With reference to your report No.12240 on the "DUNJA" it is noted you state the vessel's class has been transferred to the Bureau Veritas.

It is also observed that your last date of survey was the 21st February and that the report was not written until the 2nd ultimo. It is concluded that the reason for the delay is that you were awaiting to advance the survey, but I have to request that you will explain the position in regard to this vessel by means of a letter.
