I have to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them reports received from the Society's Surveyors at Dunkirk and Antwerp of surveys carried out in December last, from which it is noted this vessel has been examined in drydock, the screwshaft drawn for inspection, the Special Survey of the hull completed and the Special Survey of the machinery advanced.

Notations of s.s.Dnk.-9,52 and IMC MS 3,52 will be assigned when the stator of the main circulating pump and its inlet and outlet pipes, also No.2 intermediate shaft bearing are renewed on the vessel's return from the present voyage by March next.

No.4 intermediate shaft bearing required to be re-examined on the vessel's arrival at Dakar before the end of last month, and it is concluded that this matter is now receiving attention. } x

A fresh record of Drydocking 12,52 and notation of Screwshaft Survey 11,52 have been assigned at this time.
