S/S "Camille Gilbert".

We hereby beg to acknowledge receipt of your favour of the 29th ult. and contents noted.

Regarding to the survey of boilers we can inform you, that we have sent the captain a copy of your previous letter to this matter, dated 8/6-26, and have asked the captain to let the boilers be surveyed when coming to Europe.

As the captain now has come home, we have to day asked him about this matter, and he told us, that engineer Damslett, surveyer for North Veritas at Hamburg, in the month of March when the steamer was repairing in said harbour, promised the captain to arrange with your firm regarding the survey. The captain also told us, that no agent from yours had vicitied him to this matter in Antwerp.

As you will know the steamer has left for Cape Race, but will end January discharge a cargo coal in one port of U.K., and should like to take the inspection there.

With regard to the notice in the Shipping Press, that the vessel has grounded twice on her receipt stay at Sydney C.B. we can inform you, that the steamer always has touched the ground at that place, when taking bunkers on board, but as it is soft ground, the vessel has had no serious damage.

If it is necessary we can, when steamer is coming to England arrange an inspection by the Society's surveyors, and you will then could point out the damage steamer has arised.
