Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 14th instant respecting the case of the Steamer "CAMILLA GILBERT" (your first entry report No. 72986) I have to inform you that the proportion of the fee which will be chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the survey during construction of the engines of this vessel up to the time of transfer to private ownership, will be 20% of the difference between the fees as for Standard machinery and the ordinary classification fees, which will amount to say £15:0:0.

An account has to-day been rendered to the Ministry of Shipping for this fee and your account will be credited accordingly on payment.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
