The Lloyd's Agents' Surveyor at TOWNSVILLE reports (5,52) ship examined on slipway, bottom coated, and the requirements of a Special Survey (D), due 9,52, complied with, and minor repairs effected. On account of damage (cause not stated), repairs effected to shell plates (p.s.f.).

The thicknesses of shell plate as ascertained by drilling are stated above and are considered satisfactory.
