The ODYNIA Surveyors report (1.50), this trawler placed in dry dock, bottom coated, and rudder pintles and bushes renewed.

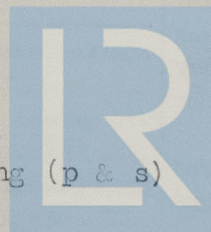
The set over stem and stem plating as above continues efficient, and now recommended to be specially examined and dealt with as necessary by 1.51.
