

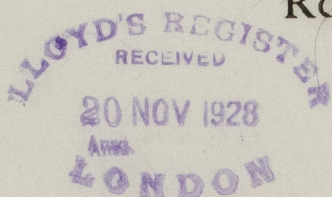

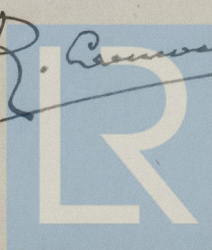
The removing of the Refrigerating Machinery and appliances is also taken in hand.
