Nature of Survey

The 2nd s.s.No.2, due 5.28, has been partly held.

The London Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock and the special survey completed. The bottom has been recoated and repairs effected to floors in boiler room tank.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with record of survey 5.28 and notation of S.S.Lon.No.2-28.
