"AWAJISAN MARU" I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 12th instant, the contents of which have been noted, and would inform you that the vessel's class has accordingly been continued without special condition.

"ISE MARU" Before your Report No. 2325 receives the consideration of the Committee I shall be glad if you will forward the torsigraph records or extracts together with full particulars for examination in this Office, as requested in the letter of the 2nd June last (Ref. Eng.).

It would appear that there are only 14 transverse bulkheads in the ship for entry in the Register Book and not 15 as reported, but I shall be glad to receive your confirmation on this point.
