M. I duly received Mr. Turnbull's letter of the 25th instant enclosing a plan in duplicate showing proposals by Messrs. Sir W.G. Armstrong, Whitworth & Co. (Shipbuilders) Ltd., to convert the existing coal bunker of the S.S. "GONZENHEIM" into an oil fuel bunker.

I have, however, to inform you that a letter has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Bremen enclosing one from the Owners, Messrs. Unterweser Reederei A.G., dated 16th instant, in which they state that they do not desire to retain the vessel's class with this Society, and that they had had her classed with the Germanischer Lloyd on the 11th instant. The case received the consideration of the Committee at their Meeting today, when it was decided to withdraw the class from the Register Book and to insert three dots (...) in lieu thereof.

In the circumstances the plan in question has not been dealt with, and is returned herewith.
