hull examined.

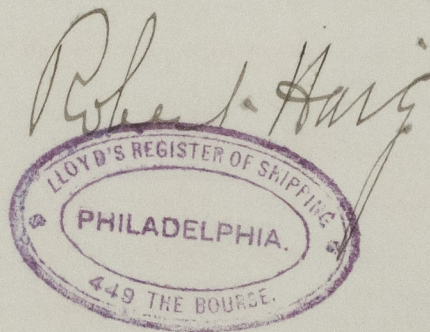
No damage apparent.
