With reference to your classing letter of the 8th instant regarding the above vessels we have to inform you that the thickness of the keel plating at ends is 20 lbs., and the equipment of ropes is in excess of that required being as follows:-

- ✓ 6 @ 50 fathoms 9" Steel Wire,
- ✓ 6 @ 50 fathoms 7" Steel Wire,
- ✓ 4 @ 120 fathoms 4" Steel Wire,
- ✓ 4 @ 120 fathoms 3" Steel Wire,
- ✓ 4 @ 60 fathoms 3½" Steel Wire,
- ✓ 6 @ 120 fathoms 2½" Steel Wire,
- ✓ 2 @ 120 fathoms 1½" Steel Wire,
