In reply to your classing letter of the 1st instant in connection with the motor vessel "JOSEPH FLINT", Leith Report No. 19419, we beg to inform you that overall length of this vessel is 142.75 feet, and that the length of the Raised Quarter Deck is 43 feet. The thickness of the flat keel plate as fitted is .375" throughout and the thickness of the Raised Quarter Deck side plating is .375" to .31" and not as stated on our report. ✓

We regret the above omissions and mistakes on the report in question. ✓

The maximum compass deviation due to electric currents was found to be nil degrees on all courses.
