This vessel was built in June 1913 and classed 100A1 Stm Trawler.

The class was withdrawn at the Owners' request in September 1925.

In a letter from the Lord Line Limited it is noted that they desire the vessel to be reclassified. She is at present at Buckie undergoing reconditioning under the authority of the Ministry of War Transport.

In order to have her class reinstated in the Register Book it will be necessary for the requirements of a 2nd S.S. No.3 to be complied with, all parts of the structure drill tested where deemed necessary by the Society's Surveyors and full particulars of the equipment on board furnished.

If it should be impracticable at the present time to carry out the full requirements for the Special Survey, arrangements should be made for the vessel to be submitted to the requirements of Circular 1772 including dry docking with a view to notations of 100A1 Stm Trawler, Reclassification Contemplated and "Examined" with date being assigned.

It is submitted the writers might be informed accordingly, the Aberdeen Surveyors advised and the First Entry Report forwarded to them for guidance in dealing with the case.
