The 2nd S.S.No.3 due 10,36 has been partly held and to complete the Survey a considerable part remains to be done.

The results of the drilling of the shell plating have been approved.

In September last the trawler was reported to be laid up indefinitely and the usual undertaking was furnished.

The Liverpool Secretary now forwards a letter from the Fleetwood Surveyor enclosing one from the Owners, intimating their desire to withdraw the trawler from class.

The Surveyor adds that it may be expected that the Owners will withdraw several other trawlers from class rather than incur the expense necessary to put the vessels through Survey.

The year of grace expired at the end of October last.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
