Dear Sir,

I beg to enclose herewith letters from the Owners of the steam trawlers "ARIAN" and "NANCY HAGUE" requesting that the class of both vessels be withdrawn.

These two vessels were overdue for Special Survey, the year of grace in each case having expired at the end of October last.

In my letter of the 14th July last regarding overdue surveys in the case of vessels owned or managed by Messrs. New Docks Steam Trawling Co. (Fleetwood) Ltd., I drew attention to the possibility of several of these old vessels being withdrawn from class.

Two others of this fleet were withdrawn recently, "YARMOUTH" and "HERO" and it may be expected that the Owners will prefer to withdraw several others rather than incur the expense necessary to put the vessels through survey.

The "AGNES WICKFIELD" (28 years) "GWENLLIAN" (26 years) and the "ROMAN" (28 years) will probably be dealt with in the same way as soon as the year of grace has been fully exploited and I venture to add that in my opinion the Society will be well rid of these vessels.
