
THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of U. D. Mallory Corp.

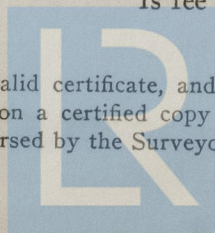
The Renewal Survey has been carried out at this time.
