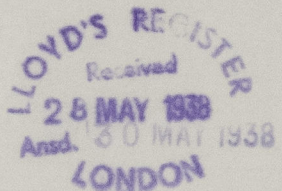

 is being forwarded herewith.

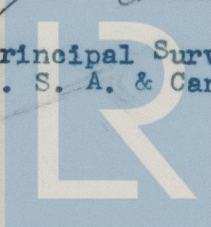
In explanation of the delay in forwarding this Report
