With reference to your report No.3126, I shall be glad to learn what arrangements the Owners propose making to complete the Special Survey by the internal examination of No.4 centre double bottom tank.

I have to add that the validity of the Provisional Load Line Certificate expired on the 31st ultimo and I shall be glad to learn what arrangements the Owners propose making to carry out the Renewal Survey.

No.4 centre bottom tank is used as a distilled water tank for the Water Tube Boilers, and could not be examined internally at this time, as No.4 P and S tanks, the only tanks that can be used for transferring from No.4 centre, had their pipe and valve connections dismantled for repairs. Arrangements have been made for this item to be dealt with on the vessel's return to this port in about four months time.

A freeboard Survey has been carried out, and a provisional Certificate issued which is being forwarded herewith.
