Dear Sir,

With reference to the Special Survey which became due on the steamer "STRYMON" at the end of February last, I have to acquaint you that the vessel is understood to have been renamed "LIBERTY" and transferred to the Liberian flag. In reply to enquiry Messrs. S. Livanos & Co. Ltd. of London wrote as follows:-

"She has recently been sold to the Compania Maritima Internacional of Panama and we understand that she is being transferred to Liberian Flag. Our Owner friends have therefore no further interest in this ship."

It is understood, however, that the new Owners are managed by Messrs. S. Livanos & Co. Inc., 52, Broadway, New York, and in these circumstances I shall be glad if you will let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made for the Special Survey in question to be carried out.
