Reverting to my letter of the 19th ultimo, the Committee have had before them a report from the Society's Surveyors at Calcutta, from which it is noted that the Boiler Survey, partly held in October last, has been completed.

The Surveyors state that a number of starboard boiler plain and stay tubes are becoming thin, and they consider it will be advisable to renew these at the next Boiler Survey.

The Committee have accordingly assigned to the vessel a fresh record of B.S. 10,50 subject to this matter receiving attention as recommended, and it is concluded you will make arrangements to this end.
