Wear and tear repairs

Two manhole doors refitted and a number of plain tubes renewed. One stay tube stopper in starboard boiler starboard box has now been renewed and the Surveyor recommends that the tube be renewed at next BS.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible for the record BS 10.50, subject as recommended.

Note: The Surveyor states that a number of starboard boiler plain and stay tubes are becoming thin, and he considers it will be advisable to renew these at the next BS. He therefore suggests the Owners be advised to have the necessary spare tubes available.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Owners be informed accordingly.
