Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

The following alterations have now been carried out and found satisfactory:-

In way of additional accommodation for gunners in after 'tween decks:-

Port side:- Four extra sidelights fitted, each with hinged C.I. deadlight.  
Three 6" dia. ventilators fitted, leading to new accommodation;  
substantial coamings 3 ft. high, with wood plugs and canvas covers.  
One extra W.C. discharge above main deck, with screwdown non-return valve controlled from upper deck.

Starboard side:- Three extra sidelights fitted, each with hinged C.I. deadlight.  
One 6" dia. ventilator fitted, leading to new accommodation;  
substantial coaming 3 ft. high, with wood plug and canvas cover.
