The following additions have been made in connection with accommodation for Gunners in after 'Tween decks P.S.:-
2 coal ventilators now fitted on Port side of foreboard deck, coamings 6' dia, 2'-10" high x 5/16" thick. Wood plugs & canvas covers provided. W. Co. previously fitted at Starboard side of 'Tween decks, with a discharge on shell above 2nd deck, having an automatic storm valve with positive means of closing controlled from the foreboard deck.
