With reference to your enquiry of the 28th July, 1942 regarding "EMPIRE FAIRY" and "EMPIRE GOBLIN", First Entry Reports Nos. 51664 and 51665, the Combustion Chamber bottom plating is $\frac{3}{4}$ " in accordance with the approved plan No. 11014, approved in Newcastle on 3.7.41 for Amos & Smith's Boilers Nos. 705 and 706 which is enclosed, and the wrapper plate seams are single riveted as shown on the plan. The question of heat treatment does not therefore arise. As requested, the approved Pumping Arrangement Plan is enclosed. We would be obliged if you would return both plans at your convenience.
