We are in receipt of your letter of the 25th inst informing us that you have had a memorandum from the Society's Liverpool Office stating that the Steam Trawler "Unitia" was sold about two months' ago to the River Ness Fishing Co. Ltd of Aberdeen, no survey having been carried out prior to the ship's departure from Fleetwood where she had hitherto been laid up.
