"We have communicated on several occasions with the Director General de Navegacion y Pesca Maritima, Madrid, but this gentleman does not appear to know anything regarding the above vessel and has forwarded all our correspondence to the Sr. Comandante de Marina at Bilbao.

"I have had two interviews with the Sr. Comandante of Marina and this gentleman is not aware that this vessel is the property of the Spanish Government.

"As we have solicited information from the Director General in Madrid, and also from the Marine Authorities at Bilbao, who are not aware of the vessel, we regret we are unable to make any arrangements for this vessel's boiler survey.

"We might suggest that even though this vessel did belong to the Spanish Government in all probability she would not retain our class as the Inspectors of the Comandancia of Marine attend to all surveys of the Government vessels."

In the circumstances the Committee deferred consideration of the case for two months.

On the 23rd August the Bilbao Surveyors forwarded a copy of a letter received by them from the Comandancia de Marina of Bilbao, reading as follows:-

"The Director General of Navigation in a letter of 14th instant states as follows, viz:-

'Please inform Lloyd's Register's Representative in your City as a reply to his letters respecting the Fishing Vessel "ALEXANDER PALMER" that no survey should take place until such a survey is requested.'

In reply to enquiry the Bilbao Surveyors now write they have not yet received any information in regard to the trawler.
