I. Dear Sir,

With reference to correspondance which has passed between us since February last, respecting the boiler survey of the steam trawler "ALEXANDER PALMER" we beg to state that we have communicated on several occasions with the Director General de Navegación y Pesca Marítima, Madrid, but this gentleman does not appear to know anything regarding the above vessel and has forwarded all our correspondance to the Sr. Comandante de Marina at Bilbao.


I have had two interviews with the Sr. Comandante of Marina and this gentleman is not aware that this vessel is the property of the Spanish Government.

As we have solicited information from the Director General in Madrid, and also from the Marine Authorities at Bilbao, who are not aware of the vessel, we regret we are unable to make any arrangements for this vessel's boiler survey.

We might suggest that even though this vessel did belong to the Spanish Government in all probability she would not retain our class as the Inspectors of the Comandancia of Marine attend to all surveys of the Government vessels.
