With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "ALEXANDER BALMER", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had under their consideration a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Bilbao in which they state they have written to you in regard to the survey of the boiler, which became due at the end of December last, but have received no reply to their communication.
