This vessel was built for the Admiralty in 1917 by Messrs. Smith's Dock Co. Ltd. under the supervision of the Surveyors to the British Corporation and is now at Southampton undergoing survey with a view to classification with this Society.

Plans of the machinery were mutually approved by this Society and other Classification Societies.

A plan of the boiler has now been forwarded for consideration.

It is submitted that provided the working parts of the engines be opened out and examined, and be found in good order and safe working condition and in accordance with the Rules, the sizes of the shafting be checked and be found in accordance with the ^{Rules} ~~Admiralty specification~~; the boiler be examined throughout, the scantlings be as shown on plan and the boiler otherwise be in good condition, and the pumping arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Rules, the machinery of this vessel might be accepted for the original working pressure of 180 lbs per square inch and a notation of L.M.C. (with date) without the distinguishing mark $\text{\textcircled{R}}$ be assigned.
