Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Ferro-Concrete Vessels "CRETECAMP", "CRETEHIVE", "SKOGLAND I" and "SKOGLAND IV", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have recently had under consideration a request that the notation "Experimental" at present standing against the classification of Ferro-Concrete vessels should be removed from the Register Book.

As the result of an examination of the reports of surveys held on these vessels since they were built, the Committee have determined to agree to the request to remove the notation "Experimental", and this will be done at the next re-printing of the Society's Register Book, subject to an opportunity being afforded the Society's Surveyors of making a general examination of the vessels, including a survey of the bottom in drydock, and to its being ascertained that the vessels continue to do their work satisfactorily.

The work of preparation for the forthcoming edition of the Register Book is shortly to be taken in hand, and I shall be glad to learn whether you propose placing the above-named vessels in drydock in the near future, with a view to the necessary examination being made by the Society's Surveyors in these cases.
