The First Special Survey No.1 became due at the end of last month.

In July last, the Trieste Surveyors stated that it was the desire of the Owner to have for this vessel a class for unlimited service in the Mediterranean, and to make occasional voyages to Antwerp. In reply he was informed that for the proposed service, the scantlings and arrangements should be made equivalent to the requirements for the unrestricted 100A- class, and if the figure "1" was desired, the equipment on board must be made equivalent to the requirements of the Society's Rules.

In reply, the Owner states that he is not disposed to carry out the work indicated and that the classification of the Registro Italiano only is sufficient for his purpose for the present. He therefore desires to have the class of the vessel removed from the Society's Register Book.

The case received the consideration of the Classing Committee on Friday, 29th ultimo, when it was decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.
