Messrs Martinolich & Co of Lusingpiccolo, survey a steel boiler at Sampierdarena, said to have been made by Messrs N.Odero & Co of Genoa in 1909 for the Steamer "RIDANO" belonging to the Impresa di Navigazione sul Lago Maggiore, & to have been removed from that vessel. -

This boiler is 2500 <sup>m/m</sup> metres outside diameter, and 2800 <sup>m/m</sup> metres long, it has two corrugated furnaces c. 900 metres in diameter, common to one combustion chamber, & is calculated for a working pressure of seven Kilograms per square centimetre. It is said to have been in use for about six years, & on examination was found to be in satisfactory condition. - The steam dome .900 metre in diameter & .860 metres long, has been temporarily removed in order to facilitate the removal of the boiler to its destination.

The dimensions of this boiler were compared with those of the design & found to agree. -
