Freeboard markings assigned by the Committee have been cut the planking on the ships sides as follows:-  
 Board from centre of disc to top of deck line (wood deck)...4ft. 0 ins.  
 Water Line above centre of disc...4ins.

This certificate is valid for the contemplated voyage and is in force until 7th July, 1943.
