Mr. Turnbull is at present on a week's leave of absence, having departed hopefully last Saturday for a "restful" time at Streatham, though I believe he found the climate rather too warm in London and returned home two days ago.

In the circumstances I am acknowledging your letter of the 11th instant regarding the bower anchors in the case of the "ECEABAT". The Ministry of Shipping were, of course, in accordance with the Emergency Regulations unable to permit this vessel and the sister vessels to be supplied with three bower anchors, and probably I should have made a statement to this effect upon the First Entry Report.

To place the matter in order I am, as you will see, sending forward an official letter today.
