Reverting to your letter of the 16th instant respecting a proposal to place Messrs. John Harker's No.34 ("JOHN HARKER") on the Coryton to Hull Service, I am directed to inform you that the matter has received careful consideration, and having in view the absence of a forecastle and the arrangements of machinery casing, which provide the only means of protecting the machinery space, it is considered that this vessel is not suitable for the North Sea service, and the Builders should be informed accordingly.
