Madam Dolly Seah and cabled you as follows :-

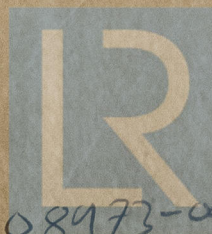
" REYURCAB TWENTYNINTH OWNER STATES DUYONG AND
