Eastern Anchorage, Singapore.

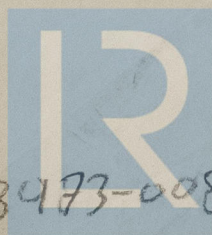
They request us to defer any surveys due
