Dimensions:- 141.25 x 23.5 x 9.66

This ship is a duplicate of the Builders Yard No.629 "EMPIRE BOXER" (see statement sent to Reports Department, at Wokingham, 28.2.44), except that electric welding is to be employed to a greater extent, the deck plating, shell in way of tanks, and bulkhead seams etc., being welded.

The plans were approved for the class 100A1 "carrying petroleum in bulk", a suitable notation to be made in the Register Book to indicate the extent to which electric welding is employed.

There is nothing further in the Hull correspondence affecting the First Entry Report which is not covered by the approved plans.


