M I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd ultimo respecting the freeboards for your new steamer "SILVER SHELL" (Yard No. 434), and with regard thereto I have pleasure in sending herewith the usual letter giving particulars of the freeboards assigned to the vessel.

At the same time I have to inform you that these freeboards are the minimum admitted by the Tables for the particulars and dimensions reported. The measurements and particulars have been carefully compared with those for the S.S. "MELANIA", to which you refer, and it is found that the differences, particularly in the sheer measurements, fully account for the difference of half-an-inch between the freeboards assigned in these cases.


