With reference to my classing letter of the 28th ultimo and to my subsequent letter of the 2nd instant respecting the steamer "SUNFLOWER", I have to acquaint you that Mr. Clarence Smith, of the Vacuum Oil Co., has since called at this Office and stated that the increased rudder has been reduced in area, and in these circumstances I return herewith the plan, in order that you may indicate the exact size of the rudder now fitted in the vessel.

From the correspondence which has taken place in regard to this matter you will see the necessity for submitting to this office any proposed increase of rudder area before the work is undertaken, and I shall be glad if you will be guided accordingly in any similar instance.


