Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 13th April last having reference to Motor Barges "Y-126", ex "L.T.C.No.1", "Y-127", ex "L.T.C.No.2, and "Y-128", ex "L.T.C.No.3", and the matter having been referred to the U.S.Army Authorities I enclose herewith copy of their letter of the 11th June from which you will see that classification by this Society will no longer be required in view of the service in which these small tankers are now engaged.

As their letter of the 11th did not give the names of the vessel a further inquiry was addressed to the Army Service Forces in Washington, who now confirm that the small tankers referred to in their previous letter are the above named vessels.
