With reference to the motor barges "Y.126", "Y.127", and "Y.128" (ex "LTC No.1", "LTC No.2" and "LTC No.3"), I think it well to inform you that after the arrival of these vessels in this country, they came under the jurisdiction of the United States Army Authorities and it is now understood unofficially that the vessels are likely to be used in service on the River Seine. The Committee feel that in these circumstances the Society will not be required to define fresh limits of service for these vessels in European waters and that maintenance of the Society's Class may no longer be required, but I shall be glad if you will take the question of these vessels up with the appropriate Government Department on your side and advise me in due course of their intentions in regard to the maintenance of class with this Society.
