Repairs, as above, to rudder post in way of outer plate (E.W. 8.41 and previous dates) and to shell plate (s.s.f) (E.W. 3.42) specially examined and found efficient. The Surveyors recommend deletion of these items from conditions of class.

Indented shell plating as above examined and remains efficient.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed, with record of docking survey 1.47, and to have notation of 'S.S. ann. - 1.47' assigned as recommended, subject to indented shell plating etc. (p & s) being dealt with at the first convenient opportunity, but without other condition.
